**Tate - Year 3 Project**  
Turner Prize-winning artist and Oscar-winning filmmaker Steve McQueen unveils his epic portrait of London's Year 3 pupils at Tate Britain. Steve McQueen invited every Year 3 pupil in London to have their photograph taken by a team of specially trained Tate photographers. They included children from state primaries, independent schools, faith schools, special schools, pupil referral units and home-educated pupils. Our current year 4 children had their photographs taken in October 2018 and will be visiting

Tate Britain to view their picture in April 2020.

These class photos are brought together into a single large-scale installation, capturing tens of thousands of Year 3 pupils in a milestone year in their development.

The exhibition is free to visit and is open Monday - Sunday 10am - 6pm.


### First Sunday of Advent.
