Provision in 2011-12

Pupils eligible to benefit from the PPG during 2011-12 will have benefited from one or more of the following, which have been funded or part funded through the PPG:

- 1 to 1 tuition 10 x 1hour sessions for pupils not working at age expected levels in writing
- ECAR support for pupils in year 1 and 2 working below age related expectations –part funding the cost of the ECAR teacher
- Year 3, Level 2C ipad Reading project x 5 pupils
- Part funding additional teacher to team teach in year group where pupils were performing below age expected

Measuring the impact of PPG funding in 2011-12

- 12 pupils; 1 pupil made expected progress, 8 pupils made above expected progress and 3 pupils did not make expected progress.
- 6 pupils supported – 4 out of 6 pupils achieved exit level, with 2 making accelerated progress. This group will be monitored during 2012/13
- 1 pupil achieved the exit level for the programme (2 sub levels) -4 pupils exceeded the exit level (1 level and above)
- All pupils made 5.11APS in reading and 5.32 APS + in writing

Priorities for support from the PPG funding in 2012-13

- Numbers Count Teacher to support the lowest attaining pupils to accelerate progress
- 1 to 1 tuition for mathematics
- Additional support identified following end of autumn term data analysis to support any pupils at risk of not achieving end of year targets
