Commissioning Mass



Registration forms are for children in year 3 or above and will be available for the next two weeks.

School Dinners Year 3 Pupils

School dinners for year 3 children
As mentioned in our end-of-year newsletter, children who have just entered year 3 no longer benefit from the universal free school meal entitlement. This means that if your child is not eligible for free school meals because you are not receiving certain benefits, then you will need to pay £2.10 per day (£10.50 per week) payable from Tuesday 4th September. **If your child is eligible for free school meals, or if you're not sure about their entitlement, you should contact Hackney Learning Trust as soon as possible to enquire about entitlement and to complete the relevant forms to assess your eligibility.**



Dinner Money

Thank you to all the parents that have settled any outstanding dinner money debts. If you have yet to do so your child will need to bring in a packed lunch from Monday 10th September. Dinner money is currently £10.50 per week and must be paid at the beginning of every week. Please put money in an envelope with your child's name and class clearly marked. Thank you for your co-operation.



Mobile Phones

While we recognise that mobile phones are a part of everyday life for children, it is important to remember that they can be a serious distraction in school and that they can also be used to bully or intimidate others. For this reason we would like to remind all parents that their children must not take mobile telephones into class or use them throughout the school day. Where a pupil needs to bring a 'phone into school, for example because they walk to and from school without adult supervision, it must be left with the school office at the beginning of each day.

Any use of a 'phone, including inappropriate photographing/filming

or bullying, may lead to the phone being confiscated. The parent will be told to collect the phone at the end of the school day.
