Summer Fayre

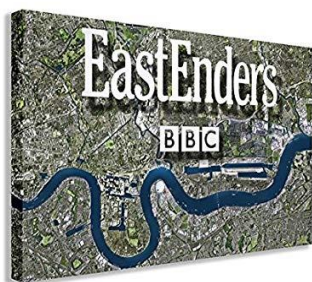

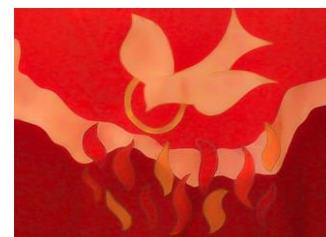
