#### Secondary Transfer 2023

Parents/carers of pupils in year 6 recently received a booklet outlining the process for choosing a secondary school for September 2023. Open days and evenings have been taking place in and out of the borough and we know that many of you will be attending these to help inform your choices.

Secondary school applications need to be made online via the eAdmissions system. The deadline for making your application is Thursday 20th October.

Please note the following important points when making your application:

- Once you have registered successfully, you will receive an email from eAdmissions.
- It is essential that you do not delete this email as it is necessary for completing the eAdmissions secondary transfer process. E-mails from eAdmissions may go to your junk/spam folder so please check these too.
- 3. If you have used eAdmissions to make an application in the past (e.g. for another child), login with your email address and password from your previous application. If you cannot remember your username or password click the 'Forgotten username or password?' link.

Parents/carers should complete the applications at home themselves but if you would like the school to assist you with your application then Ms Finan would be more than happy to support you. If you would like some assistance please make an appointment at the school office.

Can parents please ensure that contact details are kept up to date. It is essential that we have current telephone numbers for at least three adults who we can contact in case of illness, emergency or absence.


