### Hay fever

Hay fever is usually worse between March and September, especially when it's warm, humid and windy. This is when the pollen count is at its highest.

Symptoms of Hay fever include:

- Sneezing and coughing
- A runny or blocked nose
- Itchy, red or watery eyes
- Itchy throat, mouth, nose and ears.

Items could include:


Non-perishable food and drink
